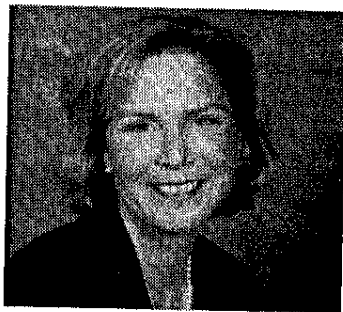


Concord realtor has top sales
